Deven Fontaine #44 rides a DRR named, The Screaming Green Machine. He is 7 years old and originally from Burrville, RI. We now reside in Brooklyn, CT.

Deven began his love of ATV's at a young age of 2 1/2 years old. He began racing the NEATV series at the age of 4. At just 32lbs and 37 inches tall he was the smallest and youngest rider, but held his own in 2005 and took 8th place over all out of 29 riders that season.

Over the next couple of years Deven, still the smallest and youngest rider, held his own. In 2006 he took 4th place out of 35 riders at the NEATV and 2nd place at the Rock Maple Racing Series. In 2007, at the age of 6, he took 6th for the season with 27 riders in the NEATV. These were learning years with some really bad crashes I'd rather not relive. However lessons needed to be learned.

In 2008, Deven was a force to be reckoned with. Definitely earning his name "Diamond D" on the Screaming Green Machine. Deven raced hard with more heart than I've ever seen. He is still the smallest rider at 44 inches tall and only 41 lbs. But don't let his size fool you. He won 1st place 6 out of 9 races taking the Championship with 425 points for the 2008 NEATV season.

Deven loves racing. It's in his soul. He practices as much as he can on his personal track at home. He has a goal to be the best of the best and his dream is to become a Kawasaki sponsored Pro like Josh Creamer.
